- Life Orientation with an achievement level of at least three (3).
- · Aligned with the language policy of the university, English as a language of learning and teaching with an achievement level of at least three (3).
- The required minimum levels of achievement in specific subjects as stipulated in the Calendars of each Faculty, provided that:
- ✓ Four 20-credit subjects were achieved with a minimum NSC achievement level of four (4) for degree programmes and

## **International Student**

**Admission Requirements** 

To be considered for Undergraduate admission, international applicants must qualify for a Matriculation Exemption from the South African Matriculation Board, they must meet the University of Limpopos' language requirements, and they must meet the minimum Faculty entry requirements as indicated. The medium of instruction and examination at UL is English.

The minimum requirement for admission is a Matriculation Exemption or completion of O and A level examinations. If you only have the O level or IGCSE examinations, you will not be eligible for a Matriculation Exemption; you should nplete the first year of study at your home University before applying to the University of Limpopo. Upon completion of first year of study, you can then apply for foreign conditional exemption from the Matriculation Board / Universities South Africa (USAf) formally known as Higher Education South Africa (HESA). For students who have matriculated or acquired their degree (s) outside South Africa, you are required to have the evaluation certificate before applying to study with the University of Limpopo. Those who intend to enrol for undergraduate degrees, are required to first apply for the evaluation certificate from USAf.

\*NB. Before registration (or renewal of registration) all International Students must provide proof of VALID STUDY VISA and VALID MEDICAL AID COVER Full details of matriculation regulations are given on the Matriculation Board website: www.usaf.ac.za or www.saqa.org.za

### First time application for a study permit requirements:

- a. Department of Home Affairs application form (BI-1738) b. Valid passport which must be valid for at least 30 days after the end of your proposed stay in South Africa, otherwise your permit will only be granted for the period up to 30 days before the expiry date. It should also have at least one unused page left when arriving in South Africa.
- c. Application fee for the permit. This is non-refundable even if your permit is
- d. An official letter from UL confirming provisional acceptance and the duration of the Course. This is a letter from the relevant Faculty offering a study place, together with proof of your acceptance of the offer

Students from other African countries are not required to pay this deposit provided that the government of their country submits a written statement undertaking to pay all costs relating to deportation of the student should it become necessary.

### 2. Matriculation Certificate (prior 2008)

 Students, who successfully completed Grade 12 before 2008, can apply for admission to the University with the normal Grade 12 Senior Certificate with full university exemption by converting their grade

### 3. National Certificate (Vocational)

- Students who have successfully completed a National Certificate Vocational NC(V) Level 4 qualification will require the following and will be subject to Faculty Admission Specifications and Placement Tests:
- NC(V) level 4 certificate with 3 fundamental subjects 60% (Life Orientation included) and 4 relevant vocational subjects at 70% for degree programmes.
- NC(V) level 4 certificate with 3 fundamental subjects 50% (Life Orientation included) and 3 compulsory vocational subjects at 60% for diploma programmes

### 4. The Admission Point Score (APS) system

The system is a simple calculation, using your NSC or Grade 12 university exemption results, which can be done by any prospective student to determine if he/she meets the minimum requirements to gain entry into:

- The University of Limpopo
- A specific programme of choice offered by a Faculty within the


